What are ELEs?

ELEs are outstanding teachers, who are middle and senior leaders with the skills to support individuals or teams in similar positions in other schools. They understand what outstanding leadership of evidence-informed school improvement looks like and are skilled in helping other leaders to achieve it in their own context.

Duration:

There is no pre-defined time commitment for ELE work as models and types of deployment vary according to need and capacity.

Commitment:

Successful applicants must have a commitment to outreach work, the capacity to undertake such work, and with the full support of their Headteacher.

Cost:

There is no cost to apply. Successful applicants will be entitled to training from the Research School. When outreach is planned and booked, the Research School will cover all costs to the ELEs home school, including supply cover.
