





This week, Year I have

Home learners from Year 4 were thinking about Children's mental health this week. Lily spent time outside, Maxwell and Lillie S produced wonderful posters.








Ethan from Year 5 certainly rose to the challenge of making his own obstacle course last week! It went round the whole house! Well done Ethan!

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Last week, Year 1 were learning about floating and sinking. They carried out their own experiment to test different materials. Super work Year 1!











More Year 1 investigations...






Alex from Y5 and Maya from Y1 have had a very busy time at home. Their mum told us ... 'This morning we went to have some fun in the snow.

Alex did some 11+, today was English so bit challenging.' Glad to see you are working hard and playing hard!


